Condition: Good condition. The original finish shows moderate wear consistent with age and use. The top has faded and shows scattered light scratches, small impressions, and various small stains, as well as a few stable, minor, and partial seam separations. The leaves are slightly darker than the primary table top, and three leaves show more advanced wear including some larger darkened water stains. The table base shows similar light wear throughout, and there is one larger chip to the end of one through-tenon measuring 1 x 1



inches.
